Materials:

- ·white paper
- pencil or crayon
- ·orange crayon
- ·scissors
- ·glue stick or glue

Instructions:

- ·Fold paper in half
- ·Place hand on white paper with fingers squeezed together and thumb extended as far as possible
- Trace around hand
- ·Use marker or pencil to draw on a small wing and eye
- ·Use orange crayon to draw on a beak
- ·Add a small triangle to the back for a tail.
- ·Cut out bird while paper is still folded (you'll have two birds).
- •Glue the bodies together, up to the dotted line.
- ·Fold the two wings back so that the dove can fly.
- ·Have fun flying your Dove of Peace!


Taping a penny or attaching a paper clip below the wings may help it to fly farther.




The Rainbow Sign






Day 3 Jesus made me smart. Just like God made King Solomon smart as he prayed, we can become smart as we pray and trust the Lord.

- 4. Tape the hands together as shown.







- 6. Open up to see the family chain.




Boaz Marries Ruth




Day 5 Jesus made me to live with Him forever! Make an eagle or chariot of fire.


- 1. Color the patterns on both sheets.
